Introduction to DMC

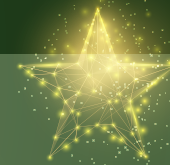

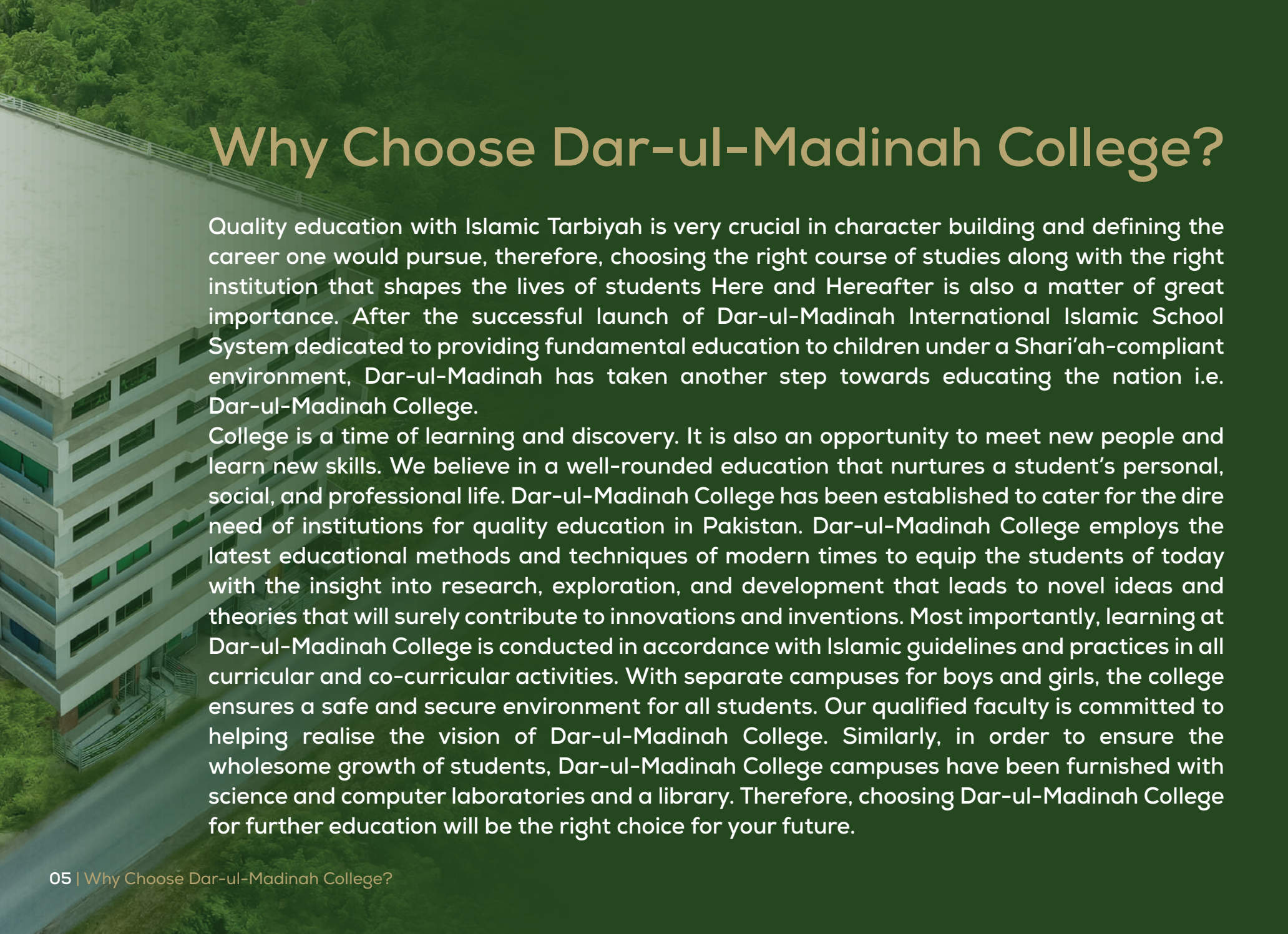

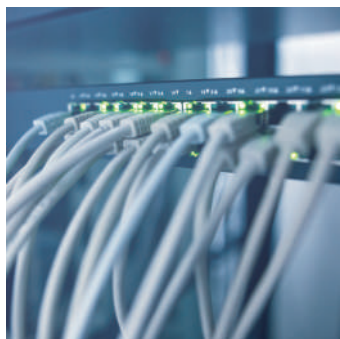


Security

places. Besides learning through observation, students have the opportunity to meet experts in their respective fields.

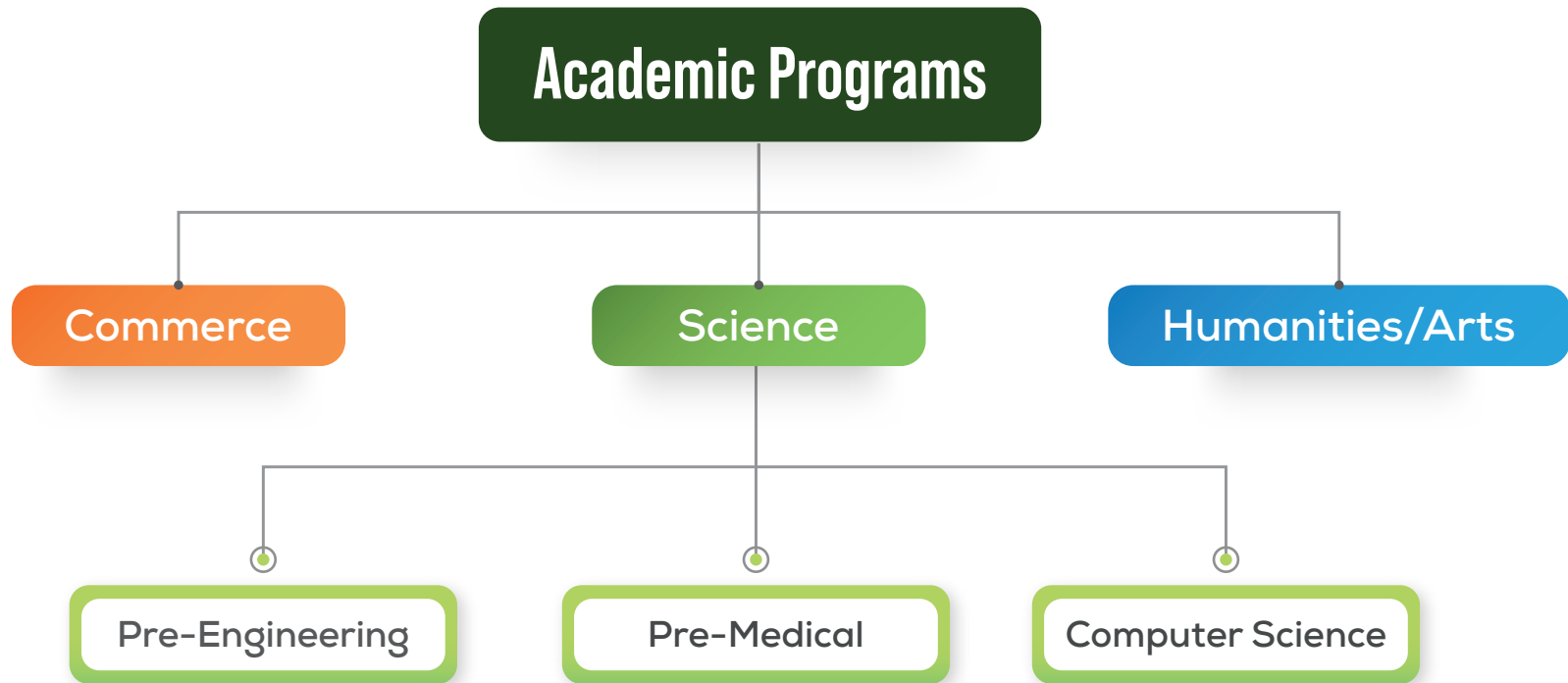
Counselling

2. Appear in entrance test and interview

- Appear in Dar-ul-Madinah College computer-based admission test (English, Maths and General Knowledge and Urdu) and admission interview on the date notified by the admission office via website/SMS/e-mail/mobile app.

3. Check the merit list

- A list of shortlisted candidates is displayed on specified dates on the campus notice boards as well as on the Dar-ul-Madinah College's admission website by the respective admission offices.
- Candidates will be asked to bring the relevant documents to the admission office for verification within a specified time frame.

4. Admission offer and acceptance

- If offered admission, students/parents will receive payment detail via SMS with a unique payment/transaction ID/e-voucher through email or at your unique ID or mobile application.

2. DM Family (DMF)

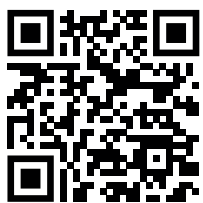
